Around 13:00 Island Folk take to the stage. This very popular and talented local act will perform a range of folk and Irish classics. There promises to be plenty of foot tapping and singing along!

Later in the afternoon, from around 15:00, Robin James Hurt and Mick Morris are up from Dublin and on stage performing their unique mix of folk, with blues and rock influences, including many original tracks.

The music continues in the evening giving Larne people a real reason to have a superb night out in their home town.
